SHALL MARSHALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS, SALINE COUNTY, MISSOURI BE AUTHORIZED TO INCREASE ITS ADJUSTED OPERATING TAX LEVY \$0.99 PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2049, AND TO USE SUCH FUNDS FOR OPERATING COSTS AND TO ACQUIRE, CONSTRUCT, RENOVATE, FURNISH, EQUIP AND IMPROVE NEW AND EXISTING SCHOOL FACILITIES (INCLUDING REFINANCING EXISTING LEASE AGREEMENTS)?
