<p style="text-align: center;">For United States Senator (Vote for 1)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Constitutional Amendment No. 4 <i>Proposed by 101st General Assembly (Second Regular Session) SS 2 SJR No. 38</i></p> <p>Shall the Missouri Constitution be amended to authorize laws, passed before December 31st, 2026, that increase minimum funding for a police force established by a state board of police commissioners to ensure such police force has additional resources to serve its communities?</p> <p>This would authorize a law passed in 2022 increasing required funding by the City of Kansas City for police department requests from 20% of general revenue to 25%, an increase of \$38,743,646, though the City previously provided that level of funding voluntarily. No other state or local governmental entities estimate costs or savings.</p>

This is intended to make childcare more available, which would support the well-being of children, families, the workforce, and society as a whole.</p> <p>State governmental entities estimate the state's Blind Pension Fund could have annual lost revenue of up to \$400,000.
