**RE: Impact Notices, Holding an Informal Meeting and BOE Appointments**

Saline County Assessor Jessica Adcock-Goodman has announced the Board of Equalization will hold hearings beginning at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, July 19, 2022, at the office of the Saline County Commission – Room 101. Any taxpayer who disagrees with the assessed valuation of their real estate or personal property established by the assessor for the tax year of 2022 may hold a hearing appointment to present their issues regarding their assessment.

Property owners who wish to appeal their assessments are to hold an informal hearing with the assessor's office by calling 660.886.3111 or by coming in person to the assessor's office located at the Courthouse – Room 202 – to discuss your concerns. If you wish to schedule a BOE appointment after the informal hearing with the assessor, you may do so by contacting the county clerk's office to schedule the appointment. The last day for making BOE appointments will be Wednesday, July 13, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. **The forms necessary for completion for this process may be printed from the clerk's website at: [www.salinecountyclerk.com](http://www.salinecountyclerk.com).**

**Any taxpayer who wishes to schedule a BOE appointment will need to call the county clerk's office at 660.886.3331 to schedule their BOE appointment. If you do not print the forms from the clerk's website, they may be mailed to you. You may also come by the office to schedule the BOE appointment and pick up the necessary forms at that time. PLEASE NOTE BELOW THE OPTIONS FOR RETURNING THE COMPLETED FORMS PRIOR TO YOUR SCHEDULED MEETING. After the BOE hearing has concluded and the taxpayer is dissatisfied with the decision that has been made by the Board, an appeal may be taken on to the State Tax Commission for further consideration.
