RE: ASSESSMENT APPEAL PROCESS, INFORMAL HEARINGS, AND BOARD OF EQUALIZATION APPOINTMENTS

The Board of Equalization will hold hearings beginning July 20, 2026, at 9:30 AM in the Saline County Commission Office, Room 101. Any taxpayer who disagrees with the assessed value of their real estate or personal property for the 2026 tax year may schedule a hearing to present their concerns.

Property owners wishing to appeal their assessment must first complete an informal hearing with the Assessor's Office by calling 660-886-4380 or visiting in person in Room 202. After completing the informal hearing, if you wish to proceed with an appeal to the Board of Equalization, please contact the Saline County Clerk's Office at 660-886-3331 or visit in person.

The deadline to schedule an appointment with the Board of Equalization is July 17, 2026, at 4:30 PM. All necessary documentation must be submitted by this deadline. Required forms are available at the Saline County Clerk's Office or online at www.salinecountyclerk.com. If you are unable to print the forms, they may be mailed, emailed, or picked up from the Clerk's Office.

After all documentation has been filed with the County Clerk's Office, you may schedule your appointment with the Board of Equalization. Please note that all appointments must be scheduled through the Saline County Clerk's Office prior to the filing deadline.

If you are dissatisfied with the Board's decision, you may file an appeal with the Missouri State Tax Commission for further consideration.
