RE: Impact Notices, Holding an Informal Meeting, and BOE Appointments

Saline County Assessor Jessica Adcock Goodman has announced the Board of Equalization will begin holding hearings at 9:30 a.m., on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, at the office of the Saline County Commission to hold hearings for taxpayers who disagree with the values of real estate and personal property established by the assessor for the tax year of 2021. It is planned that hearing appointments will conclude by 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, July 29, 2021. Assessor Goodman stated the new assessments have been made and notices have been sent to taxpayers who have been impacted by these new assessments.

Property owners, who wish to appeal their assessments, are to hold an informal hearing with the assessor's office by calling 660.886.3111 or coming by their office located in the county courthouse – Room 202 to discuss your areas of concern prior to making a board of equalization appointment. If it is still your desire to make a Board Of Equalization appointment, you may do so by contacting County Clerk Debbie Russell to schedule a date and appointment time, and to obtain the forms needed in preparation to present evident before the BOE to establish what you believe to be the correct value of your property. The last date for making BOE appointments is 4:00 p.m., on Wednesday, July 14, 2021. The necessary form(s) you will need for your BOE appointment may be printed from this website. **Please pull the form(s) from this site at [www.salinecountymo.org](http://www.salinecountymo.org) – County Clerk's tab or visit [www.salinecountyclerk.com](http://www.salinecountyclerk.com). You may call the county clerk's office (660.886.3331) to have the forms mailed to you or come by the office to pick the forms. See the options below for returning the form(s).**

If the property owner is still dissatisfied with the assessment after their meeting with the BOE and a decision has been made, the appeal may be taken on to the State Tax Commission.
